

SPEEA members voting today on Spirit AeroSystems contract offer



Wichita – Technical and professional workers at Spirit AeroSystems will hear about, and vote, on the company’s contract offer at 5 p.m., today, in the Mary Jane Teall Theater of Century II. Doors open at 4 p.m.

The news media is welcome to attend the meeting, which starts at 5 p.m. with a presentation of the offer by the Wichita Technical and Professional Unit (WTPU) negotiation team of the Society of Professional Engineering Employees in Aerospace (SPEEA), IFPTE Local 2001.

SPEEA is recommending union members reject the company’s offer.

After the meeting, union tellers will tally the votes at the SPEEA Midwest office. The news media is invited to be at the office for the announcement, expected at about 7 p.m. Results will also be posted on the union website at www.speea.org.

SPEEA represents 2,300 technical and professional employees at Spirit AeroSystems in Kansas.

Overall the union represents 24,400 employees in Washington, Kansas, Oregon, Utah and California. SPEEA is affiliated with the International Federation of Professional and Technical Engineers (IFPTE).
