Background

Per both SPEEA Constitution and SPEEA By-Laws 2.3.2 (“Requirements for Holding Office”)

“Council Representatives must have been Regular Members in good standing of SPEEA continuously for the preceding twelve-month period”

I took my T-10 Council Representative office in August 2018.

I had a medical accident on November 4th 2018.

Election for Council Representatives is scheduled to finalize on May 16, 2019.

My break in service occurred during 2018 which means I will not qualify for re-election to T-10 without a waiver.

My health has recovered significantly, and I foresee no periods of Leave Of Absence (LOA) during the 2019-2021 term that would interfere with my serving SPEEA members as a Northwest Council Representative

I request waiver for my break(s) in SPEEA membership during my approved LOA's to run for election to the T-10 Council Representative position for the 2019 – 2021 term.

It is moved that: THE SPEEA COUNCIL WAIVES the continuous membership requirements to hold office per both the SPEEA Constitution and SPEEA By-Laws Sections 2.3.2 for Tony Hickerson resulting from interruptions in his services as a T-10 Council Representative as a consequence of his no-fault incident.
